1) Candidates having minimum 60% aggregate marks (6.5/10 CGPA) in each of the examination of (i) 12th level and (ii) Bachelor's degree of full time three year duration from a recognized university with Mathematics/ Statistics/Business Mathematics as one of the subjects in any one semester /year in the above (i) and (ii) mentioned courses, are eligible. SC/ST Candidates with minimum 55% aggregate marks (6.0/10 CGPA) are eligible.

6) How to Reach NITK : All Service/Express Buses starting from Mangalore Bus  
Stand and going towards Udupi, stop at NITK Main  
Building. A number of Private Taxis also available  
at Mangalore. NITK is 21 Kms. from Mangalore on the  
northern side on National Highway No.17

7) Mangalore Airport & nearest  
railway station : Mangalore Airport is just 20 KM. from the campus  
and there are flights to Mumbai, Chennai and Bangalore  
every day , with connections to rest of the country. The  
The nearest railway station is Surathkal ( 3 Km) on the  
Konkan Railway ( Mangalore –Mumbai), is the nearest  
rail station and is the stopover for most trains passing  
through Konkan Railway. While Surathkal and  
Kankanady are closest alighting points for visitors  
coming by train from North; Mangalore is the Terminus  
for many trains from South India.
