**NOTICE INVITING e-TENDERS [On e-Procurement mode in CPPP portal]**

1. National Institute of Technology Karnataka, Surathkal (in short - NITK, Surathkal; hereinafter referred as the "Institute") is an autonomous Educational Institute of the Ministry of Education, Government of India, imparting technical and science education. NITK, Surathkal is one of the "Institutes of National Importance" notified by the Govt. of India under the NITSER Act – 2007 (Act No. 29 of 2007). The Institute is fully funded by the Government of India; and is governed by NITSER Act.
2. The Institute hereby invites e-tenders for the below mentioned work from the eligible registered contractors of KPWD/ CPWD/ Electrical Inspectorate (Govt. of Karnataka) of appropriate class:

The e-tenders invited are on techno-commercial basis on e-Procurement mode. **The intending bidders shall submit their bids through the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal-URL: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.** Any tender, if submitted off-line (Manually) shall not be entertained.

3. **The work mainly involves supply, installing, testing and commissioning of 5 numbers of 11kV indoor type VCBs (moving part only) with all connected accessories after dismantling the existing old VCBs. The VCBs should suit to the existing setup of VCB panel, including modifications, if any, in Control circuit wiring.**

6. **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD):** The intending bidder must submit a '**Bid Security Declaration**' declaring disqualification of his bid in case the bid is withdrawn or modified by him during the bid validity period. The format of 'Bid Security Declaration' is available in the Tender Document. 'Bid Security Declaration' duly signed be uploaded while submitting the e-bid. **Tenders received without the 'Bid Security Declaration' will be rejected** (except in the case of NSIC/MSME enlisted bidders (under relevant NIC & Activity) / Startups).
7. **Performance guarantee:** The successful bidder shall deposit a performance guarantee of 3% of the bid amount (as accepted) through RTGS/NEFT/ in the form of Bank Guarantee (in approved format) / Demand Draft / FDR of any scheduled bank drawn in favour of the **Director, NITK, Surathkal** payable at Surathkal, on intimation before executing the Contract Agreement.
8. **Security deposit:** The successful bidder shall deposit a further **security deposit of 2.5%** of the bid amount (as accepted) through RTGS/NEFT/ in the form of Bank Guarantee (in approved format) / Demand Draft / FDR of any scheduled bank drawn in favour of the **Director, NITK, Surathkal** while executing the Contract Agreement **OR** the same shall be deducted from the contractor's work bills.
9. The bidders enlisted under NSIC/MSME/ startups are requested to note that the present notice inviting tender is **not for the "Supply of Goods"**, but for engaging a contractor under **works contract**. If bidders enlisted under NSIC/MSME (**under relevant NIC & Activity**) are interested in participating in the tender, they may participate subject to fulfillment of the conditions of this notice inviting tender. **However, they are exempted from paying EMD.** The 'Startups' as recognized by the Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) are also exempted from paying EMD. **Considering the nature of work which require experience in handling VCBs, there is no exemption from previous experience.**
10. **Minimum eligibility criteria for qualifying in Technical bid:** The intending bidder must satisfy all the following requirements for qualifying in the technical bid:
- 10.1 The bidder must be a registered contractor of appropriate class as mentioned in column (6) of Para (2) above. A self-attested copy of registration should be uploaded to e-Procurement portal while submitting e-bids.
- 10.2 The bidder must possess GST registration – self attested copy should be uploaded.
- 10.3 The bidder must possess PAN registration – self attested copy should be uploaded.
- 10.4 The bidder must be registered under Employees Provident Fund (EPF) Act – self attested copy should be uploaded.
- 10.5 The bidder must be registered under Employees State Insurance (ESI) Act – self attested copy should be uploaded.
- 10.6 The bidder must have the experience of having **successfully completed** similar work as follows during the past seven financial years (Enhancement at simple 7% per annum shall be considered to bring it to the current costing level) in any Central Government department/ State Government department/Central or State Government undertakings/ Central or State government autonomous bodies/Public or Private Sector Units/ Private firms Central Government department/ State Government department/Central or State Government undertakings/ Central or State government autonomous bodies/Public or Private Sector Units/ Private firms:
- (i) At least three similar works, each work costing not less than ₹ 8.45 lakh; OR
- (ii) Two similar works, each work costing not less than ₹ 12.68 lakh; OR
- (iii) One similar work of not less than ₹ 16.91 lakh.

**Similar work means electrical works comprising SITC of Vacuum Circuit Breakers / Installation of Electrical HT substations.**

Self-attested copy of Work Experience certificate issued from Central Government department/ State Government department/Central or State Government undertakings/ Central or State government autonomous bodies/Public or Private Sector Units/ Private firms (**with copy of TDS certificate in case of**

**Private firms) should be uploaded. Considering the nature of work which require experience in handling VCBs, there is no exemption from previous experience for the intending bidders enlisted under NSIC/MSME/ startups.**

11. Self-attested copy of related document should be scanned and uploaded while submitting e-tenders. The price bid of only such bidders whose technical bid is accepted shall be opened.
12. Time is the essence of the contract and hence the work should be completed within the stipulated timeframe. Bidders, who in their opinion have the capacity to complete the work within the stipulated timeframe, shall only participate in the e-tender. Participation in the e-tender shall be deemed as the bidder has the capacity to complete the work within the stipulated timeframe.
13. A Works Contract Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidder on prescribed Form No. CPWD -8. Bidder shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form, which will form part of the agreement. Price escalation clause is not applicable to this work. Any further details required may be obtained from the office during the office hours.
14. The Institute reserves the right of rescheduling the calendar of events, make modifications to tender document before its submission by the bidder, cancelling the tender or accepting any bid other than the lowest or rejecting all the bids.
