- 2. Abstracts should be within 300 words with 3 to 5 keywords. It must include a clear indication of the Title, purpose of research, and theoretical framework/methodology.
- 3. Full Paper: It should be written following the MLA/APA style sheet (8<sup>th</sup> Edition).
- 4. The length of each paper should be 6000 words, excluding works cited and notes.
