Withdrawal

The candidates who wish to withdraw the seats are required to send a scanned copy of duly signed handwritten withdrawal request letter along with provisional admission Order (IRIS generated sent through email) to academicdocuments@nitk.edu.in during 11th to 14th August 2022, clearly specifying their application ID. They are required to send a copy of Bank passbook first page for account details. The email should have a subject line as: "Withdrawal from Ph.D / M.Tech (Research)/Self financed PG Programme -2022-23".

The email should be sent from the email id of the candidate which is registered in IRIS portal only. The email received from any other email id will not be processed. The email sent to any other email id, other than academicdocuments@nitk.edu.in will not be processed.

Such candidates who have submitted the withdrawal letter as above, will be eligible for refund of the amount paid at the time of online admission in the IRIS portal deducting the processing fee of Rs. 1000.

The refunds will be made tentatively after 30th September, 2022.

If the withdrawal letter is sent after <u>14th August 2022</u>, then such candidates will be eligible for the refund of only security deposit.

The classes for first semester M.Tech (Research), Self Financed PG Programme and Ph.D students for the academic year 2022-23 would commence from **August 18, 2022**. The Academic Calendar will be made available in the Institute website soon.

1. Banking Facility

SBI and Canara Bank Branches with ATM facility are available on Campus. All students must compulsorily open SB account in either of above two branches and inform the academic section of their SB account numbers

2. Hostel Facility

Hostel facility is available for all the students. Hostel Room Allotment will be done to the admitted students on completing the physical reporting and document verification formalities and students can stay in the hostels from the date of physical reporting itself. However, Mess facility will be available from the date of allotment of room.

3. How to Reach NITK

All Service/Express Buses starting from Mangalore Bus Stand and going towards Udupi, stop at NITK Main Building. A number of Private Taxis also available at Mangalore. NITK is 21 Kms. from Mangalore on the northern side along National Highway No.66

4. Mangalore Airport & nearest Railway station

Mangalore Airport is just 20 km. from the campus and there are flights to Mumbai, Chennai and Bangalore every day, with connections to rest of the country.

The nearest railway station is Surathkal (3 km from NITK) in the Konkan Railway route (Mangalore –Mumbai route), and has stopovers for most trains passing through it. While Surathkal and Mangalore are closest alighting points for visitors coming by train from North; Mangalore Central is the Terminus for many trains from South India
