From the academic year 2018-19 and subsequent revision in 2021-22, the course structure for first – year B.Tech are not common due to different programme specific core courses and engineering science core courses to be registered by the students of various branches in the first year. The students who opt for branch change have to register for such first year courses specified in the course structure of the new branch allotted during their higher semesters. The student has to register for additional courses ranging from 1 to 7 courses depending on the branch change opted from one discipline to another discipline.	After the detailed deliberations, the senate resolved to approve the abolition of branch change process from the academic year 2023-24 and for those admitted in 2023 and later.
The branch change option is becoming not feasible because, the students are facing difficulties in registration of additional courses in higher semesters due to their higher semester academic load (which includes the opted minor courses) and clash in time table slots of higher semester courses and first year courses. This aspect has increased the burden on the students who opted for branch change, which is affecting their academic performance as well.	
The branch change is carried out only against the vacancies in any branch which are very much in negligible proportion as compared to the sanctioned strength of that branch. As it is evident that branch change option is not feasible due to associated complexities, burden and logistic issues, it is recommended to abolish the branch change process from academic year 2023-24.

Agenda Item

According to Clause 8 (c) of Ph.D. Regulation, if a student fails to submit satisfactory Research Proposal within two and a half years of joining the programme, the Ph.D. registration of such a student is liable to be terminated. The students who are terminated from the Ph.D. programme are being given an opportunity to re-register for the programme, after an assessment of their work progress by Re-registration Committee and approval by Chairman, Senate based on the Committee recommendation. The Institute Senate vide 34-BOS - 17 under Item No. 50.3.1 had approved the Guidelines for Ph.D. Re-registration after termination at the end of seven years of registration. However, these guidelines do not cover the cases of termination due to delay in submission of Research proposal.

In view of the above, the Institute Ph.D. Re-registration Committee (constituted to assess the work progress of the Ph.D. candidates for giving recommendations on Re-registration) discussed the matter in its meeting held on 13th December 2022 at 4.15 PM.

The committee has recommended the guidelines for Reregistration of students who are terminated from Ph.D. programme for not submitting the Proposal within the stipulated time frame.
