4. Instructions to the candidates

A. Physical reporting and admission

The date of physical reporting, document verification and admission for all the candidates who have been allotted a seat at NITK Surathkal through JoSAA and CSAB 2025 is scheduled during $20^{\text{th}} - 25^{\text{th}}$ August 2025 (as per the schedule given below).

Candidates are advised to fill their details through the NITK IRIS portal on clicking the MIS link mentioned below and pay the prescribed Institute's fee / Hostel's Fee before final physical reporting and admission. (If it is not possible to fill-in the details before reaching NITK, arrangements will be made to use the computer facilities at NITK).

- Original Certificate of category (OBC-NCL/SC/ST), if applicable, as per Government of India, issued by the competent authority. In case of OBC category, the certificate must be issued on or after April 1, 2025.
- 9. OBC Undertaking in the format available in NITK Website (Refer previous notification)
- 10. Original Income and Asset Certificate for EWS candidates, if applicable, as per Government of India, issued by the competent authority. The certificate must be issued on or after April 1, 2025.
- 11. Original Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PWD), if applicable, issued by the competent authority and the physical verification report issued by any verifying center during JoSAA Rounds.
- 12. Original Migration certificate of last institute/university attended (If from outside Karnataka)
- 13. Original Conduct/Character Certificate from head of the institution last attended
- 14. Original Transfer certificate from the head of the institution last attended
- 15. Original Medical Fitness Certificate. (JoSAA format / NITK format)
- 16. Photo ID proof as per Govt. of India norms (Copy of Aadhar Card is compulsory)
- 17. Passport size photograph.
- 18. Adhaar card of parents and their contact number.

Photocopies of the above documents to be submitted during physical reporting for admission.

(If any certificate is in language other than Hindi or English or Kannada, translation of the same in English is to be produced with certification by the competent authority).

B. Hostel facilities

The hostel room allotments will be done at the time of physical reporting. The candidates may come prepared to stay in the hostel soon after the admission formalities. Mess facility will be available from the date of reporting to the Hostel.

Hostellers are required to pay the applicable mess fee at the time of admission to the Hostel. The mess fee is **Rs.35,310/-** for first semester.

D. Tuition Fee Waiver for B. Tech Students

- * Students belonging to General, GEN-EWS & OBC-NCL category whose family income is less than Rs.1.00 lakh per annum shall get full remission of Tuition fees (Rs.62500/-) on submission of latest income certificate from the revenue authorities not below the rank of Tehsildar issued on or after 1.4.2025.
- * Students belonging to General, GEN-EWS & OBC-NCL category whose family income is between Rs.1.00 lakh to Rs.5.00 lakh per annum shall get remission of 2/3rd of the Tuition fees (Rs.41667/-) on submission of latest income certificate from the revenue authorities not below the rank of Tehsildar issued on or after 1.4.2025.
- * Students belonging to SC/ST/PwD category are exempted from the payment of Tuition fee. (Income certificate not needed).
- * The students have to pay the full fee of first semester during the admission time. For refund of tuition fee for eligible candidates, the notification in this regard will be issued during first of week of December 2025 to submit family's income certificate issued on or after 1.4.2025. Those who need fee

remission for upcoming academic years need to submit the income certificate issued in that financial year.

* The refund of tuition fee on submission of Income certificate will be processed to such candidates only after NITK receives the fee amount from CSAB-2025 and the refund will be made on verification of the documents which is tentatively after 15th March 2026.

E. Withdrawal/refund of fee

Candidates who are not reporting physically at NITK on the specified dates after confirming the seat in JoSAA /CSAB are not eligible to claim for refund of any fee paid by them at JoSAA/CSAB portal. Candidates who have confirmed their seat through JoSAA/CSAB, physically report at NITK and complete all the admission formalities by paying the balance fee at Institute IRIS portal will be eligible for refund of only the balance fee paid at NITK after deduction of processing fee of Rs.1000/-, provided they submit the withdrawal request to Dean (Academic) in person at NITK on or before the closing date of admission i.e. 25th August 2025 by 5.00 pm (Last date of admission). They are not eligible for the refund of the fee paid at JoSAA/CSAB -2025 portal.

Candidates who withdraw the admission on or after 26^{th} August 2025 are eligible for refund of only the caution deposit paid to the Institute. They are not eligible for refund of any other fee. Candidates who are leaving the course after joining are not eligible for any refund.

Withdrawal requests sent through emails will not be processed.

F. Orientation program and Commencement of classes

The classes for first semester B.Tech. students for the academic year 2025-26 would commence from Monday, September 01, 2025. The orientation /induction programme will be held from Monday, 26th August 2025 onwards. The Academic calendar will be made available soon in the website.

Important Note:

- (1) Candidates belonging to OBC –NCL or EWS category are required to submit the certificates in the prescribed format available in the NITK website (i.e. <u>www.nitk.ac.in</u>) or in JoSAA portal and issued on or after April 1, 2025
- (2) Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL) issued by Maharashtra State must be validated by Social Welfare department (in case of SC and OBC-NCL category) and Tribal Welfare department (in case of ST category) of Maharashtra Government. The SC/ST/OBC-NCL candidates of Maharashtra State have to produce their caste validity certificate in the format available in the NITK website (i.e. <u>www.nitk.ac.in)</u>.
- (3) The candidates who belong to PWD category must submit UDID card/the certificate issued from a competent authority in the prescribed format.

G. Banking Facility

SBI and Canara Bank Branches with ATM facility are available on Campus. All students must compulsorily open SB account in either of above two branches and inform the academic section of their SB account numbers.

H. Location and how to reach NITK

The National Institute of Technology Karnataka (NITK) is located in Mangalore City, Karnataka, India. It is situated along the Kanyakumari-Mumbai National Highway 66. Mangalore, also known as Mangaluru, is a coastal city in the southwestern part of Karnataka, and NITK is positioned in the outskirts of this city with a campus set amid 300 acres of lush green surroundings with the Western Ghat Mountains to the east and the Arabian Sea to the west. With a temperature range of 18 to 38 degrees Celsius, the location has a fairly moderate and pleasant climate throughout the year and the fact that the campus is situated on the seashore adds an extra element of appeal with a refreshing and healthy climate. This location provides not only a peaceful and conducive environment for academic activities but also convenient connectivity to major cities in India and international destinations via road, rail, and air. All Service/Express Buses starting from Mangalore Bus Stand and going towards Udupi, stop near NITK Main Gate. A number of Private Taxis also available at Mangalore.

Mangalore Railway Station, located about 20 km away from the campus, ensures convenient rail access. Additionally, the Surathkal Railway Station being approximately 3 km away further enhances the connectivity for the NITK community. The Mangalore (Bajpe) airport being in close proximity, about 20 km away, adds to the ease of transportation. This airport serves as a vital link for both domestic and international destinations, making it convenient for students, faculty, and visitors to travel.
