### **NOTICE INVITING TENDER (NIT)**

The National Institute of Technology Karnataka, Surathkal (in short – NITK, Surathkal) is an autonomous body under Ministry of HRD Govt of India, a Deemed University, imparting Technical Education and engaged in Research Activities. It is proposed to procure the items for the departmental academic/research activities.

Sealed Tenders are invited for the following items in <u>two cover system</u> (i.e., Technical bid and financial bid) subject to the following terms and conditions, from the reputed manufacturers or its authorized dealers so as to reach this office on or before scheduled date and time. The tender (Technical bid) will be opened on the same day if possible in the presence of bidders or their authorized agents who may choose to be present. The financial bid of only such bidders whose technical bid is accepted shall be opened on the same day or later pre-informed date.

#### **SECTION 1: INSTRUCTIONS TO THE BIDDERS(ITB)**

- 1. The bid should be submitted in two cover system-Technical Bid and Financial Bid:
- 1.1 **Envelope No.1 Technical Bid:** The agencies should give details of their technical soundness and provide list of customers of previous supply of similar items to Universities, Institutes or Government Departments/ Undertakings/ public sectors with contact details. The details of the agency/ profile should be furnished along with the copy of all related documents. This envelope should be sealed and duly super-scribed as "**Envelope No. 1 Technical Bid**". Full name and address of the agency should also be mentioned on envelope and should be addressed to **The Director, NITK, Surathkal.**

#### 1.2. Documents to be submitted with the technical bid:

- a) The agency should possess **Licence certificate** for manufacture /supply of the item.
- b) List of Owner/partners of the firm and their contact numbers
- c) The agency should possess **Income tax PAN number.**
- d) The agency should possess **GST registration.**
- e) Catalogue of the Product with detailed product specifications.
- f) List Service Centres and **List of customers** with contact details.
- g) The average annual turnover should not be less than 30% of the estimated cost put to tender/quotation for the job work. The copy of the Balance sheet, Profit & Loss A/c., Trade or Manufacturing A/c for the last 3 years should be enclosed
- h) Warranty Period Offered for the tendered item to be specified. If the Warranty period is not conforming with the schedule of requirements given in section 3 of the document, the bid is liable to be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
- i) EMD in original form valid for minimum six months, through Bank Guarantee or crossed DD only, drawn on any scheduled bank in favour of "Director NITK, Surathkal", payable at Surathkal should be submitted. EMD shall bear no interest. Any bid not accompanying with EMD is liable to be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
- j) Contract form given in section 5 need to be submitted.

- 3 The tender will be acceptable only from the **manufacturers or their authorised** dealers/suppliers.
- 4. The Institute **reserves the right to visit to the factory** before or after issue of supply order to satisfy itself regarding quality of production. In case of any remarks /default noted, the EMD will be forfeited even if pre-qualified.
- 5. The Financial bid shall be in the format of Price Schedule given in Section 4. The Contract form as per format given in section 5 shall be submitted. Incomplete or conditional tenders will be rejected.
- **6.** Details of item to be supplied, approximate quantity and the specifications are mentioned in "Section 3" appended to this Notice Inviting Tender.
- 7. The item to be supplied should be strictly according to the specifications and subject to test by the institute/concerned authorities. It must be delivered and installed in good working condition.
- 8. The Institute **reserves the right to cancel or reduce the quantity** included in the schedule of requirements at any time after acceptance of the tender with a notice. The Contractor/Supplier shall have no claim to any payment of compensation or otherwise whatsoever, on account of any profit or advantage which he might have derived from the execution of the work/supply in full but he did not derive in consequence of the foreclosure of the whole or part of the works.
- 9. Performance Security of 5 % of contract value in terms of Bank Guarantee by scheduled banks shall be given by the successful bidder for the total period of Warranty.
- **10. Release of EMD**: The EMD shall be released after receipt of performance security from successful bidder.
- 11. Imports: In case, Goods are to be Imported, the Indian agent should furnish authorisation certificate by the principles abroad for submission of the bid in response to this Notice Inviting Tender.

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**12.** Validity of bids: The rate quoted should be valid for a minimum of 90 days.

No claim for escalation of rate will be considered after opening the Tender.

13. Clarification of Tender Document:

A prospective bidder requiring any clarification of the Tender Document may communicate to the contact person given in this notice inviting tender. The contact person will respond to any request for clarification for the Tender Document received not later than five working days prior to the last date for the receipt of bids

- 14. Amendment of Tender document: At any time prior to the last date for receipt of bids, Institute may for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by prospective bidder, modify the Tender document by an amendment.
- 15. Institute may at its own discretion extend the last date for the receipt of bids.
- 16. The bids shall be written in English language and any information printed in other language shall be accompanied by an English translation, in which case for the purpose of interpretation of the bid, the English translation shall govern.
- 17. The Institute reserves the right of accepting any bid other than the lowest or even rejecting all the bids. The decision of the Institute Purchase Committee is final in all matters of tender and purchase.

#### **SECTION 2: CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT.**

- 1. The rates should be quoted for preferably FOR destination from supply within India.
- 2. In case of import both CIF and/ or FOB rate should be quoted. All components of expenditure to arrive at Bangalore need to be explicitly specified.
- 3 The bidder shall indicate the excise duty exemption for the goods if applicable.
- 3 The institute is **eligible for customs duty exemption and excise duty exemption**.
- 4. The institute is **not eligible for issuance of Form C or Form D**.
- 5. The rate quoted should be on unit basis. Taxes and other charges should be quoted separately, considering exemptions if any.
- 6. Rate quoted should be inclusive of Testing, commissioning and Installation of equipment and Training, if any.


The slow speed precision diamond saw cutter is being used for gentle cutting of the reinforced concrete samples (concrete and steel) to observe the cross section.

### Sample that needs to be cut (information to the supplier):

- Sample type: Reinforced concrete sample (steel and concrete together)
- Sample dimension: 40-50 mm diameter cylindrical sample with 120 mm height
- Sample weight: 500 800 grams
- See the attached images for better understanding of the sample that needs to be cut.


## Required specifications of the slow speed precision diamond saw cutter

- Blade assembly along with coolant tank and motor drive panel with start stop switch and RPM control/display panels.
- Good quality mortar should be used for the machine.
- Specimen holder along with weight, counter poise and cut-off switch.
- Cutting speed range: 30 300 RPM with digital display.
- Load range: 500 800 grams, should be adjustable.
- Blade size: outside diameter should be minimum 200 mm and thickness 0.3 mm. The thickness may be varied according to outer diameter requirement.
- Bore diameter of Blade: Suitable with respect to above said blade dimensions.
- Number of blades: 25 blades (minimum) should be supplied.
- Sample holder: Should hold the sample of dimension 40-50 mm diameter cylindrical sample with 120 mm height, with 800 1000 grams
- Sample holder is the most important part which should hold the sample firmly and it should be flexible to hold different sizes of samples. Such as it should hold even 10 mm to 50 mm diameter cylindrical samples.
- Power: 230 V 10% AC, 200 VA (preferred).
- Complete construction details of the equipment should be provided (if necessary drawings should be provided).



- (a) Dimensions of the sample that needs to be cut (representation of Figure 'C')
- (b) 35 mm diameter cored reinforced concrete sample (concrete and steel together)
- (c) 35 mm cores encased within PVC pipe along with epoxy resin hardener (40-50 mm diameter cylindrical sample with 120 mm height)
