Applicants must ensure that all uploaded documents are **clear, legible, and complete** for verification. **Once uploaded, documents cannot be edited or replaced**, so please verify them carefully before submission.

Applicants are strongly advised to submit the form **well before the deadline**. **No extensions will be granted under any circumstances**, and applications received after the closing date will **not be considered**.

All the students must provide their own bank account details. The scholarship amount will not be transferred to any other bank account. The parents' bank accounts are also not admissible.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA OF INSTITUTE MERIT CUM MEANS SCHOLARSHIP (FRESH)

1. Merit-cum-Means Scholarship will be awarded in the institute every year to the top 50 meritorious students in the order of merit based on JEE (Main) All India Rank, subject to the condition that their parents' income is < 4.5 Lakhs and they should have $\geq 70\%$ marks at the 10+2 level or equivalent qualifying examination.
2. Students admitted under DASA, ICCR, and MEA are not eligible for the scholarship.
3. Continuation of the scholarship in subsequent years will be based on the academic performance, parents' income and conduct of the scholars.
4. Merit-cum-means scholarship awardee is eligible to continue their scholarship if their parents' income is < Rs. 4.50 lakhs and they have secured a CGPA of ≥ 7.0 at the end of the preceding academic year.
5. When a student does not meet the eligibility criteria for the continuation of scholarship in the subsequent years, their scholarship will be suspended for one academic year and will be renewed if they attain the eligibility requirements in the following academic year. This concession will not be extended beyond one academic year, during the entire course.
6. In case a student secures an I/FF grade in any course during an academic semester and gets a passing grade in the subsequent make-up examination, then they are eligible for continuation of the scholarship. If the student does not get a passing grade in the make-up examination, then their scholarship will be terminated.
7. In case a student secures an FA grade in any course, then the scholarship will be terminated.
8. If the earning parent of the Merit scholarship holders dies, or their income is permanently reduced owing to retirement or other unforeseen circumstances, the student and the family's annual income is reduced to less than Rs. 4.5 lakhs, then they may be considered for the award of Merit-cum-means scholarship, subject to the availability. This benefit will be admissible from the month in which such a situation occurs and will be available till the completion of the particular stage of study, provided the scholar fulfils other conditions. For this purpose, the parent/guardian of the scholar should submit a fresh Income Affidavit, duly supported by documentary evidence.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA OF PRADEEP GUNDAPPA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (FRESH) FOR MECHANICAL ENGG.

1. Pradeep Gundappa Memorial Scholarship will be awarded in the institute every year to one meritorious student in the order of merit based on JEE (Main) All India Rank, subject to the condition that his/her parents income is equal or less than 3.00 Lakhs per year and he/she should have obtained equal to or more than 70% marks at the 10+2 level or equivalent qualifying examination.
2. Students admitted under DASA, ICCR, and MEA are not eligible for scholarship.
3. An amount of Rs. 2,000/- per month for 8 months (4 months each semester) will be awarded as merit cum means scholarship.
4. Financial assistance will be given to a student who has been admitted based on JEE (Main) to the institute to pursue B.Tech. programme.
5. The payment of the scholarship will start from the date of admission to the **B.Tech. programme.**
6. A scholarship holder under the scheme cannot avail any other scholarship/stipend for pursuing the course.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA OF PRADEEP GUNDAPPA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (Renewal) FOR MECHANICAL ENGG.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA OF B.R. SAMAGA SCHOLARSHIP FOR SECOND YEAR B.TECH.

1. The student should be in the Second year of B.Tech. class.
2. The student should be from an economically disadvantaged background (to be judged by the committee constituted by the Trust)
3. The amount will be paid as the scholarship of Rs. 10,000/-, not in cash, but adjusted towards his / her mess bill.
4. The student should secure a CGPA greater than or equal to 6.0 in both semesters of the FIRST year B.Tech
5. Only one candidate shall be eligible for the award of this one-time scholarship.



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA OF VIJAYAKALA T D SCHOLARSHIP FOR SECOND/THIRD/FOURTH YEAR B.TECH.

1. Only B.Tech. students of the E&E Engineering Department studying in the Fourth/Third/Second year B.Tech. Students are eligible for the award of this scholarship.
2. E&E Engineering. Branch student within the Top 20 in Class with the highest CGPA.
3. Rural Background students from low-income families will be considered.
4. The first priority will be given to the **Fourth** year, and if any student is not found eligible, preference will be given to Third and second-year students in order of merit.
5. Only one candidate shall be eligible for the award of the one-time scholarship.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA OF VEERAMMA RAJASHEKARAI AH SCHOLARSHIP FOR SECOND YEAR B.TECH.

1. The student should be in the Second year B.Tech.
2. Should be from an economically disadvantaged background who is residing in the NITK, Hostel (to be judged by the committee constituted by the Trust)
3. The amount will be paid as a scholarship, not in cash, but adjusted to his / her mess bill onwards.
4. The student should secure a CGPA of 6 and above in both semesters of the First year B.Tech class.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA OF 1972 BATCH ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP FOR B.TECH. STUDENTS.

1. Award of the 1972 batch Alumni Scholarship for B.Tech. Students will be awarded in the institute every year to two meritorious students in order of merit based on the CGPA.
2. Students admitted under DASA, ICCR, and MEA are not eligible for the scholarship.
3. The scholarship is available to students who have completed their First year and are studying in 2nd or 3rd year of the B.Tech Programme.
4. The student must not be receiving any other scholarship from any other sources/ programmes/ schemes.
5. Students from rural backgrounds from low-income families will be considered.
6. Parents' income range must be less than 1 Lakh
7. The student should have maintained a CGPA greater than or equal to 6.5 in the previous academic year.
